-- Proposed Remedial Action Plan Released--

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has released its Proposed Remedial Action Plan (Proposed Plan) for the Chem-Fab Superfund Site located in Doylestown, Pennsylvania. EPA is issuing this Proposed Plan to present the Preferred Alternative for an interim remedial action to address groundwater contamination at a portion of the Site.

This Proposed Plan for interim action addresses the Area of Highest Groundwater Contamination, referred to as Operable Unit-2 (OU-2), at the Site.

The preferred alternative proposed for the Site includes installing a groundwater extraction and treatment system, construction of a groundwater treatment building, discharging treated groundwater to Cooks Run and implementing long term Operation & Maintenance of the treatment system to ensure continued protection of human health and the environment.
