

New Bedford Harbor Superfund Site, EPA Public Meeting

The Environmental Protection Agency will hold a public meeting on October 22nd in the second floor auditorium in Fairhaven Town Hall. This meeting will be held as a poster session with Q&A. Each of the EPA and MassDEP project managers will be giving 20-minute presentations at 4 different stations around the auditorium. These sessions will focus on the following topics and will allow for the public to circulate around the room and learn about particular aspects of the project in a smaller group setting.

- 1) 2014 Dredge Season, 2015 Dredging, Elaine Stanley
- 2) CAD Cell project, Dave Lederer
- 3) Overview of Human Health and Ecological Risk Assessment, Ginny Lombardo
- 4) State Enhancements Remedy Projects, Paul Craffey

Following the poster session presentations, 40 minutes will be allocated at the end of the meeting for any wrap-up questions. This time will also give agency officials a chance to clarify any questions that were particularly prevalent during the poster sessions.

* Should members of the public chose to circulate through all 4 sessions, timing will accommodate that. Others who chose to attend fewer than all 4 sessions are welcome to do so, however we ask that you do not stay at the same poster for more than one presentation so as to give ample opportunity to other members of the public to have a similar small-group discussion atmosphere. *Holding 20-minute sessions will allow for cable access to attend the meeting and film one of each session while moving through the stations.

*EPA and additional City or State participants will attempt to answer questions during each session, however certain questions require additional follow-up and we will work to do so following the meeting.
