As you know, we are preparing to undertake the soil sampling aspects of the Work Plan Addendum starting next week. We would like to confirm two items in relation to this sampling: 1. Analyte Lists

The Work Plan Addendum specified that soil samples will be analyzed for TCL VOCs and 1, 4 dioxane. In addition, the most impacted sample from each boring (based on field screening) will also be analyzed for TAL metals. 1,4 dioxane will be analyzed by SW846 Method 8270 (SIM). Additional samples will also be collected from below the water table for analysis of iron to potentially evaluate the fate of nano-iron particles introduced during the pilot testing.

2. Analytical Laboratory

EPA wishes us to continue to use Compuchem Laboratories and has clarified with NJDEP management that this will be acceptable to the Department (notwithstanding recent correspondence from the NJDEP Case Manager to EPA that expressed a contrary view). We understand that EPA has documented this agreement in writing to NJDEP and request that we be provided with a copy of EPA's letter, and some acknowledgement from NJDEP, prior to commencement of fieldwork next week.

I have also attached a copy of the revised Work Plan Addendum (which, as, you know, we had deferred submitting pending resolution of the laboratory issue).

I would appreciate if you could confirm the above items by return e-mail so that we can order sampling supplies (today if at all possible) so that we can stay on track for sampling next week. Thanks
