The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (the Department) has completed its review of the Proposed Plan for the Lightman Drum Company Superfund site and concurs with the proposed remedy. The proposed remedy consists of Air Sparging/Soil Vapor Extraction near the ground water source areas with Pump and Treat for the downgradient portion of the ground water contamination. The downgradient Pump and Treat system will be focused on areas where there are elevated levels of ground water contamination. The rest of the plume exclusive of these areas of higher concentrations will undergo monitored ground water natural attenuation (MNA). In addition, a Classification Exception Area (CEA) will be established.
