NPL Site Narrative for Wide Beach Development

WIDE BEACH DEVELOPMENT Brant, New York

Conditions at listing (December 1982): Wide Beach Development is a subdivision of 66 homes covering 60 acres on Lake Erie in Brant, Erie County, New York. The site is immediately north of the Cattaraugus Indian Reservation. Waste oils were spread on roads for dust control from the 1940s to 1978. Erie County received a complaint of odors near the site. Its investigation confirmed that PCBs exist throughout the area in soils, surface water, air, dust, and several private wells.

Status (July 1983): EPA recently completed a Remedial Action Master Plan outlining the investigations needed to determine the full extent of cleanup required at the site. It will guide further actions at the site.
