

NPL Site Narrative for Evor Phillips Leasing

EVOR PHILLIPS LEASING Old Bridge Township, New Jersey

Conditions at listing (December 1982): The Evor Phillips Leasing Site covers 6 acres in Old Bridge Township, New Jersey. A State investigation conducted in May 1982 found that drums containing explosive chemicals had been buried at the site. Both surface water and ground water are threatened.

Status (July 1983): The State excavated 30 to 40 drums; 4,000 to 5,000 drums remain buried. In May 1983, the State met with the current site owner to discuss ways in which to remedy the problem.

EPA plans to prepare a Remedial Action Master Plan outlining the investigations needed to determine the full extent of cleanup required at the site. It will guide further actions at the site.
