Dear Mr. Rudolph:

It was a pleasure meeting with you again yesterday to discuss Combe Fill Corp. and its operation of Combe Fill South located in Washington Township. As we discussed, I am enclosing copies of the previous well reports taken at the site over the past year; hereafter, you will be included on our mailing list to receive copies of all subsequent well reports which are taken on a quarterly basis.

With respect to your letter of August 22, 1980, please be advised that Combe Fill Corp. continually monitors the surface and ground water surrounding the permitted landfill property. If the contamination entering the stream does indeed originate in the landfill, the problem will be rectified immediately. We are presently taking surface water monitoring tests to determine the aforesaid origin of the contamination. On any future field surveys, you will be notified so that representatives of Washington Township may attend if they so desire.
