SUBJECT: COMBE FILL SOUTH LANDFILL
FEASIBILITY STUDY - A-95 REVIEW

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) and the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) have been working jointly formulating the necessary "Scope of Work" for a Feasibility Study which will determine the extent of contamination and the steps required to mitigate the problems presented at the Combe Fill South Landfill site. In addition, it has been recommended to post warning signs as an initial remedial action. The NJDEP and USEPA, using funds authorized under the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act, Public Law 96-510, otherwise known as Superfund, are about to initiate the work described above.

The Combe Fill South Landfill initiated operation in the 1940's. In September 1981 the site was closed. During it's operation approximately 60 acres of the 100 acre site has been used for the landfilling of solid waste. Our investigations revealed that hazardous materials have been disposed of at this site. Testing of groundwater samples has revealed the presence of numerous hazardous chemicals.

Attached please find a comprehensive description of the proposed project and copies of site maps. A formal application has not been included since the project costs have not yet been finalized. Your earliest attention to the required A-95 review for this project would be greatly appreciated since a Cooperative Agreement is expected to be signed in the near future.
