On March 28, 1989, the NYSDEC awarded a contract for "Drum and Soil, Excavation Removal and Proper Disposal at the Sealand Restoration Site" to Severson Environmental Services, Inc., of Niagara Falls, for a total price of \$11,928,620.00. The site is located in the Town of Lisbon, St. Lawrence County. The contractor is authorized to proceed with the contract work, starting April 3, 1989. All work is scheduled to be completed within 330 days from the date of authorization to proceed. The contract entails the excavation, analysis and proper disposal of an estimated 900 drums, 6000 tons of contaminated soil and debris, and 150,000 gallons of contaminated water.

Consulting Engineer

The NYSDEC is negotiating a contract with the engineering firm of Roy F. Weston, Inc., for engineering services and inspection during the construction. The consulting contract is scheduled to begin June 1, 1989. Department staff will provide all engineering and inspection services until that time.
