The sessions will be about EPA's plans to install water supply mains and connections in portions of Franklin and Greenwich Townships for properties threatened or impacted by groundwater contamination related to the Pohatcong Valley Groundwater Contamination Superfund Site (Site). There will be no formal presentation – just an opportunity to drop by any time between the hours listed above to ask questions about the plan to construct water mains and service lines associated with the Site's remedial activities.

EPA, Rio Tinto and their respective contractors will be available to discuss the activities associated with the installation of the water mains such as access to your property, constructability assessments, estimated construction schedule, and property restoration.
