U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Reviews Cleanup at Global Landfill Sanitary Superfund Site

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is conducting its second five-year review of the **Global Landfill Sanitary Superfund site**, located in Old Bridge Township, New Jersey. This review seeks to confirm that the selected cleanup is protective of human health and the environment. The selected remedy consists of the following:

- Stabilizing and capping the landfill.
- Constructing leachate collection systems and deep gas wells and vents.
- Repairing wetlands that were damaged by leachate and building additional wetlands off-site.
- Long-term groundwater monitoring.
- Institutional controls in the form of a classification exemption area, deed notices, and access agreements.

All components of the remedy have been implemented. Monitoring results show stable or improving groundwater conditions beneath the site since the last five-year review. A summary of these activities and evaluation of the long-term protectiveness of the remedy will be included in the upcoming five-year review report. **The five-year review report is scheduled to be completed February 2020.**

What is an EPA Five-Year Review?

EPA inspects Superfund sites every five years to ensure that cleanups conducted remain fully protective of human health and the environment. These regular reviews, which are required by federal law when contaminants remain at a site, include:

- Inspection of the site and cleanup technologies;
- Review of monitoring data, operating data, and maintenance records; and,
- Determination if any new regulatory requirements have been established since EPA's original cleanup decision was finalized.
