U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Reviews Cleanup at LCP Bridge Street Subsite (OU-5) of Onondaga Lake Superfund Site

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency is conducting the third five-year review of the LCP Bridge Street subsite (OU-5) of the Onondaga Lake Superfund site, located in the Village of Solvay and Town of Geddes in Onondaga County, New York. The Onondaga Lake Superfund site includes Onondaga Lake and a number of other sites that are situated on Onondaga Lake's shores or tributaries that have contributed contamination to, or threaten to contribute contamination to, Onondaga Lake. These sites, as well as the Onondaga Lake Bottom, are referred to as "subsites" of the Onondaga Lake site.

This review seeks to confirm that the cleanup conducted at the subsite continues to protect human health and the environment. Cleanup activities have included capping of the 20-acre landfill at the site and construction of a below-ground retaining wall; collection and treatment of contaminated groundwater from within the retaining wall; maintenance of on-site wetland habitats and the establishment of institutional controls.

All major cleanup activities have been completed. Long-term monitoring of environmental conditions at the subsite is ongoing. A summary of the cleanup activities and an evaluation of the protectiveness of the implemented cleanup remedy will be included in the five-year review report.

What is an EPA Five-Year Review?

The purpose of five-year reviews is to ensure that implemented cleanup remedies at Superfund sites function as intended and continue to be protective of human health and the environment. These regular reviews, which are required by federal law when contaminants remain at a site, include:

- Inspection of the site and cleanup technologies;
- Review of monitoring data, operating data, and maintenance records; and
- Determination if any new relevant regulatory requirements have been established since the original cleanup decision was finalized.

When will EPA's Five-Year Review Report be available?

It is anticipated that the five-year review report will be available at the website noted below by fall 2019.
