U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Reviews Cleanup at Stanton Cleaners Area Groundwater Contamination Superfund Site

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is conducting its fourth five-year review of the **Stanton Cleaners Area Groundwater Contamination Superfund site**, located in the Village of Great Neck, Town of No rth Hempstead, Nassau County, New York. This review seeks to confirm that the cleanup plan selected by EPA in the 1999 Record of Decision is protective of people's health and the environment. The selected plan consists of the following components:

- Extracting and treating the contaminated groundwater.
- Continued operation of the soil vapor extraction system to address contaminated soil.
- Indoor air monitoring of affected buildings near the Stanton Cleaners property.
- Long-term groundwater monitoring.
- Groundwater use restrictions.

A summary of the cleanup activities and an evaluation of the protectiveness of the implemented cleanup plan will be included in the five-year review report. The report is scheduled to be completed by **May 2024**.

What is an EPA Five-Year Review?

The purpose of a five-year review is to ensure that implemented cleanup plans at Superfund sites function as intended and continue to be protective of people's health and the environment. These regular reviews, which are required by federal law when contaminants remain at a site, includes:

- Inspecting the site and cleanup technologies;
- Reviewing monitoring data, operating data and/or maintenance records; and,
- Determining if any new relevant regulatory requirements have been established since EPA's original cleanup decision was finalized.
