This is in response to your letter of November 17, 1997 in which you express the General Electric Company's concern that the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") has not included any materials in the administrative record file for the Hudson River PCBs Site Reassessment RI/FS since 1991.

As you know, at both the October 3, 1997 meeting with Representative Solomon and at the October 8, 1997 Hudson River PCB Oversight Committee meeting, EPA committed to update the administrative record file in the near future. The Agency plans to update the administrative record file for the Site in the near future, and to update the administrative record file on a regular basis thereafter.
