Snapshot of Non-Fuel Mining in New York State

Economic Mineral Deposits and What Happens to Them

New York State ranks in or near the top third of the states in the value of its mineral production. New York's mineral resources make a substantial contribution to the state's total economy. Almost 90 percent of the mining in New York involves the excavation of sand, gravel, and limestone. These minerals are often processed through screens and crushers and used in concrete, blacktop, roadfill, and other construction projects.



While sand, gravel and limestone are valuable construction aggregates, New York also has important reserves of salt, garnet, emery, gypsum, talc, zinc, and wollastonite. New York's minerals are used to produce such things as sandpaper, wallboard, paint pigment, ceramics, brick, glass and industrial abrasives.

Mining occurs in every county except Bronx Kings, New York, Queens and Richmond.


- New York is the only state in the country producing emery and wollastonite.
