TITLE: REQUEST FOR NEW YORK STATE TO LOOK INTO REMOVING REFILL FROM THE FORT EDWARD YACHT BASIN, CHAMPLAIN CANAL.

WHEREAS, from the Railroad Bridge to the north end of the terminal wall there is approximately 50,736 cubic yards of refill in the channel, and

WHEREAS, FROM Lock 7C to Bond Creek there is approximately 7,800 cubic yards of refill, and

WHEREAS, the channel is supposed to be 12 feet deep, and

WHEREAS, this refill causes navigation of recreation and commercial tour boats in the channel to be restricted, and

WHEREAS, making it possible for recreation and commercial tour boats to come into these areas will increase economic opportunity for the area:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Fort Edward Town Board requests New York State to look into removing refill from the channel to make it possible for recreation and commercial tour boats to come into this area: and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this resolution be forwarded to Governor Pataki, Commissioner of DEC. Senator Stafford and Assemblyman D'Andrea.
