LOCKS C-1 AND C-2 ADDED TO CHAMPLAIN CLOSURE

The New York State Canal Corporation today announced that the closures along the Champlain Canal have been expanded. The Champlain Canal is now *closed* between Lock C-1 in Waterford and Lock C-4 in Stillwater due to high water levels brought on by last night's rainfall.

The Erie Canal from Lock E-2 in Waterford to E-13 in Fonda also remains closed.

These sections of the Canal will remain *closed* until the water recedes to a safer level and any debris can be removed.

NYS CANAL FROM C-3 TO C-4 CLOSED DUE TO HIGH WATER

The New York State Canal Corporation today announced that the Champlain Canal between Lock C-3 in Mechanicville and Lock C-4 in Stillwater will be *closed* due to high water levels brought on by last night's rainfall. This closure is in addition to the Erie Canal, which is closed from Lock E-2 in Waterford to E-13 in Fonda.

These sections of the Canal will remain *closed* until the water recedes to a safer level and any debris can be removed.
