Subject: Status of Avian Hudson River Data

Anne Secord at US Fish and Wildlife Service was contacted to find out when chemical data from USFWS/NYSDEC investigations of Hudson River birds would be available. She said that the analyses were being performed by Columbia Lab of the US Geological Service and that data were due beginning June 2, 2000 and were scheduled to be completed in December 2000.

Analyses are being performed for:

- -Bald eagle blood (serum), egg, prey items (eel, bullhead, carp, gizzard shad, catfish, etc.)
- great blue heron brains, nestlings, fat, liver, egg, and prey items (fish and meadow vole)
- tree swallows- adults, nestling, and eggs

Data will be released to EPA.
