On June 26, 2001, John Szeligowski and I had a phone conversation with Lech Dolata (518-457-9280) of NYSDEC with regard to the residual PCB issue in Cumberland Bay project. Mr. Dolata is the Project Manager for the construction phase and he provided us the following information:

1. There is no goal on the residual PCN concentration and the purpose of dredging is to remove the sludge bed down to the underlying sand layer.
2. The depth of dredging was based on the visual observation; if fine sludge were observed, dredging would continue; if only sand were observed, dredging would stop.
3. The pre-dredging concentration goes up to thousands ppm.
4. They are satisfied with the performance of hydraulic dredge.
