On June 26, 2001, John Szeligowski and I had a phone conversation with Lech Dolata (518-457-9280) of NYSDEC with regard to the residual PCB issue in Cumberland Bay project. Mr. Dolata is the Project Manager for the construction phase and he provided us the following information:

- 1. There is no goal on the residual PCN concentration and the purpose of dreding is to temove the sludge bed down to the underlying sand layer.
- 2. The depth of dredging was based on the visual observation; if fine sludge were observed, dredging would continue; if only sand were observed, dredging would stop.
- 3. Thepre-dredging concentration goes up to thousands ppm.
- 4. They are satisfied with the performance of hydraulic dredge.

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
