

Hudson River PCBs Reassessment Informational Meeting on Understanding the Decision-Making Process



In December, 2000, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency will issue a Proposed Plan on what should be done about the PCB-contaminated sediments of the Upper Hudson River.

In preparation, you are invited to attend an informational meeting on the process and policies EPA will use to reach this historic decision, how cleanup technologies and scenarios are evaluated, and the role of the public in the Superfund process.
