Dear Mr. Haggard:

At our meeting on November 21, 1991, at General Electric's request, EPA agreed to hold a future meeting on the various aspects of the risk assessment for the Hudson River PCBs site Reassessment. As we have discussed since that time, February 4, 1992 appeared to be an agreeable time to hold this meeting. I have estimated from previous discussions on these topics that we will need most of the day for this meeting, so I would like to start at 9:30 a.m., and finish at approximately 4:00 p.m., with a one hour break for lunch. The meeting will be held in New York City.
