During the week of June 1, technical staff from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH), and the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) will be conducting a visual inspection of an area on Rogers Island that may contain PCB-contaminated soils. This walk-through is a preliminary screening of the area of concern and does not constitute any type of decision on a remedy.

We will keep you up-to-date on the walk-through findings and other developments related to the Hudson River PCBs Reassessment.
