I am writing to suggest that we arrange for a meeting of the Hudson River Reassessment RI/FS Scientific and Technical Advisory Committee in the near future. We have not had a meeting of the Committee yet this year, and the recent publication of the Phase 2 Work Plan and Sampling Plan (Review Copy) serves to emphasize that one is needed. I agree with your decision, as discussed on June 12, that, should it be impossible to arrange for a meeting before the July 10 deadline for comments, the EPA would extend the deadline for the Scientific and Technical Advisory Committee and would accept the Committee's comments after such a meeting could be organized.
