For your information, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has scheduled a meeting of the Scientific & Technical Committee (STC) for the Hudson River PCBs Reassessment RI/FS, on Thursday, May 27, 1993. The meeting will be held from 9:45 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. at the Sheraton-Albany Airport, located at 200 Wolf Road in Albany, New York.

Scheduled for discussion is the PCB source detected near Bakers Falls, adjacent to the General Electric Hudson Falls facility.
