Dear Mr. Holmes:

This is in response to the E.P.A.'s request for information addressed to The Budd Company, Trailer Division, in reference to the Blosenski Landfill, a copy of which is attached.

Subsequent to sending a letter to Joseph J. Melvin, Esquire, dated December 18, 1984 (enclosed), I spoke with Mr. Melvin concerning the difficulties which The Budd Company had with the E.P.A.'s request for information. With regard to the time period concerning which documents and information is sought, Mr. Melvin requested that I provide information for the time period 1972 through 1979. With regard to the E.P.A.'s request for documentation concerning substances "sent to the Blosenski landfill", we agreed to produce documents concerning The Budd Company's transactions with Blosenski Disposal Service.

In accordance with the above, enclosed please find the following documents:

(1) Accounts payable records with Blosenski Disposal Company from 1974 through 1979. These records include, among other things, The Budd Company's accounts payable distribution forms, Blosenski Disposal Company invoice, receipts and "speed letters". These documents were retrieved from The Budd Company archives. While accounting and purchase documents pertaining to the period prior to 1974 were searched for, no such documents have been located.

By producing these documents, we do not admit that the waste disposed of went to the Blosenski Landfill.

(2) Purchase order file re purchase order 107807 with Joseph Blossenski. The most recent document in this file is dated 9/22/75. This file was received from The Budd Company archives. We are producing those documents which post date May 26, 1971, the date on which we understand Mr. Blossenski purchased the Blossenski site.

The undersigned reviewed the entire file kept by The Budd Company Technical Center concerning the Trailer Division. (4) Documents on file at The Budd Company, Trailer Division pertaining to "environmental matters". 
With regard to your request for copies of insurance policies of Budd, please be advised that this information is being compiled at Budd's corporate headquarters and will be sent to you in the near future.

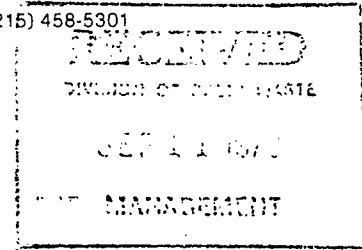

Dear Sir:

This is to confirm our telephone conversation on this date concerning your letter regarding the dumping of waste material by J. M. Blosenski.

We have also, since our conversation, taken the time to discuss the matter with Mr. Blosenski and have visited the dumping site mentioned in your letter.

Our Mr. D. Shively and Mr. A. Hellberg visited the site with Mr. Blosenski. They found empty drums that did come from our plant, but the contents were only what paint or undercoating material had adhered to the sides and a small residue at the bottom. They found no five gallon cans nor any evidence of paint spilled on the ground.

According to Mr. Blosenski, he uses this site as a storage place for empty steel barrels, junk automobiles, and other metal waste. Our people did see junk automobiles and scrap metals.

Again, according to Mr. Blosenski, the barrels or containers that contain paint or undercoat are taken from the plant to a place in West Chester where they are pumped out and disposed of elsewhere. He will supply us with the name of the place. He then takes the empty barrels or containers and stores them at the site that we visited. Incidentally, so that we are looking at the same place, this site is located on Route 340 near Wagontown, Pennsylvania.

As I mentioned in our telephone conversation, we dispose of no liquids or sludges other than paint or undercoating material, and this, for the most part, consists only of material left on the sides or bottom of the barrel by the pumps.

Mr. Blosenski hauls away all of our normal trash, wood, paper, sweepings,

etc. When we have barrels containing old paint or the normal empty barrels, these are segregated and hauled away as a separate contract for which we pay a premium. In the future, Mr. Blosenski will provide us with certification stating that the material has been disposed of as prescribed by law.

If you have any further questions, I am at your disposal, no pun intended.

Gentlemen:

The Department of Environmental Resources is presently conducting an investigation into the deposition of various types of waste material on property owned by Joseph M. Blossenski, Jr. in West Caln Township, Chester County. This site is not permitted or approved for disposal of solid wastes. Of particular concern to the Department are several fifty-five gallon drums and five gallon cans containing liquids and sludges. Many of these containers are open or have ruptured, thus permitting the wastes to flow across and seep into the soil on the property. Vegetation has been killed in some areas and there is a potential for polluting ground and surface waters. According to container labels, it appears that some of the waste material originated at your plant.

The Department requests that you promptly provide this office with any available information concerning the nature of the wastes deposited at this site. The Department further requests that you promptly notify this office of the steps you will take to prevent such unlawful disposal of your industrial wastes in the future.

On August 21, 1978, in response to numerous complaints from area residents and local government officials, an inspection of the above captioned former landfill site was conducted. I was accompanied by Wayne Lynn and Trooper Patterson of the Pennsylvania State Police. Prior to the inspection a search warrant was obtained from District Justice John Catanese. Upon arriving at the site we spoke to a resident of the trailer who attempted to phone Mr. Blossenski. After being told Mr. Blossenski could not be reached, we left a copy of the warrant with the resident and proceeded with the inspection. A copy of the warrant was also left on the gate.

Site conditions at the time of the inspection are shown on the attached sketch. It is obvious that a substantial amount of waste has been deposited on the site over the past several months. The construction waste fill area appears to be an on-going operation while the fill area behind the trailer was worked last month. The location and nature of the large ash pile implies that bulky wastes are frequently burned on the site. Deposited along with the bulk waste are some 100 to 200 fifty-five gallon drums. While most of the drums are empty, an estimated 40 to 50 do contain liquids or sludges. Of these some 20 to 30 are leaking wastes onto the ground.

The inspection also found that surface run-off from the bulky waste and drum dumping area has created three wide paths of dead vegetation, two of which extend onto adjacent property.

A series of five photographs were taken.

In view of the present condition of this site, I feel that an enforcement strategy should be developed to insure closure of the site in accordance with the 1972 Court of Common Pleas Order. History has shown that summary actions have no affect in securing such closure.
