

# Police: Teen moved into house he doesn't own

**ONTARIO, N.Y.** — An upstate New York teenager who moved into a multi-million dollar lake-side house he did not own was in jail Thursday after being arrested by police.  
 Police charged Todd Blauvelt, 18, of Gorham, N.Y., with second-degree burglary and punishable false written state-

ment Tuesday, the Democrat and Chronicle reported.  
 Blauvelt, along with his 15-year-old girlfriend and her family, were found inside the house last month on Canandaigua Lake by the property owner, New York State Police Investigator Mark Eifert said.  
 The teenager convinced his girlfriend and her family that

he inherited the house from his dead grandfather and invited them in, before the homeowner discovered the group around an hour later, Eifert said.  
 It was reported that Blauvelt had taken others to the house and told them the same story, but said his father refused to give him the house key.  
 Eifert told the newspaper,

“That justified him snooping around looking for a hidden key. Eventually, he was lucky enough to find one. He even made copies.”  
 Blauvelt was jailed in lieu of \$10,000 cash bail or \$20,000 bond. He is also charged with sexual misconduct and endangering the welfare of a child for allegedly having sexual contact with his underage girlfriend and is being held on \$5,000 cash bail on those charges.

# Malcolm X's daughter out of jail

**NEW YORK** — A daughter of slain civil rights leader Malcolm X was released from jail Thursday after pleading guilty to stealing the identity of an elderly family friend to run up more than \$55,000 in credit card bills.  
 Malukah Shabazz, 46, walked free after entering the plea at a courthouse in Queens. She had been in custody since her arrest in

North Carolina on Feb. 18. Her deal with prosecutors calls for her to pay back the money and be on probation for five years. “She’s excited to be reunited with her daughter,” said her lawyer, Russell Rothberg.  
 Shabazz could have gotten years in prison if convicted. A judge set the sentencing date for July 28, and said he intended to accept a punishment of probation and restitution.

### Environmental Protection Agency Reviews Cleanup at Butz Landfill Superfund Site

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is conducting its third Five-Year Review of the **Butz Landfill Superfund Site** located in Jackson Township, Monroe County. This review seeks to confirm that all long-term cleanup work, which included connecting 50 homes to a public water supply and installing a groundwater treatment system, continues to be protective of human health and the environment. Two previous EPA reviews conducted since 2001 have confirmed that the cleanup remedy continues to function as designed. Concurrent to this review, EPA is conducting a pilot study to evaluate possible enhancement of the groundwater treatment system by injections of agents which expedite natural cleanup processes.

#### What is an EPA Five-Year Review?

EPA inspects Superfund sites every five years to ensure that cleanups conducted remain fully protective of human health and the environment. These regular reviews, which are required by federal law when contaminants remain at a site, include:

- Inspection of the site and cleanup technologies;
- Review of monitoring data, operating data, and maintenance records, and
- Determination if any new regulatory requirements have been established since EPA's original cleanup decision was finalized.

#### When will EPA's Five-Year Review Report be available?

The Five-Year Review report will be finalized and made available in the administrative record repository for the site (see below), as well as online at <http://epa.gov/5yr> in September 2011.
