# **EPA Reviews Cleanup at the McAdoo Associates Superfund Site**

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is conducting a Five-Year Review of the McAdoo Associates Superfund Site located in Kline Township and McAdoo Borough, PA. The first Five-Year Review was completed in 1994. This fourth review will seek to confirm that the implemented cleanup, which included removing drums, contaminated soils and capping, is still protective of human health and the environment. The final document will be available August 2010.

### What is a Five-Year Review?

EPA inspects sites every five years to ensure that cleanups remain fully protective of human health and the environment. These regular reviews, which are required by law when contaminants remain at a site, include

- ➤ Inspection of the site and cleanup technologies
- > Review of monitoring data, operating data, and maintenance records
- ➤ Determination if any new regulatory requirements have been established since EPA's original cleanup decision was finalized.

#### To Review the Site:
