

EPA REVIEWS CLEANUP

East Mount Zion Superfund Site

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is conducting a Five-Year Review of the East Mount Zion Superfund Site located in Springettsbury, York County. EPA inspects sites regularly to ensure cleanups conducted remain fully protective of public health and the environment. EPA's most recent Review, conducted in 2012, determined that while the remedy continues to be protective of public health in the short term, additional investigation was needed to make a long term protectiveness determination. The progress of this additional study, as well as Agency recommendations, will be made available in the Five-Year Review Report in June 2017.
