

EPA REVIEWS CLEANUP

Middletown Air Field Site

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is conducting a Five-Year Review of the Middletown Air Field Superfund Site located in Middletown, Dauphin County. EPA inspects sites regularly to ensure that cleanups conducted remain fully protective of public health and the environment. This site was deleted from the National Priorities List in 1997. EPA's most recent review, conducted in 2012, determined that the remedy continues to be protective in the long-term. Detailed results of this current review will be made available by August 2017.
