

EPA REVIEWS CLEANUP

York County Landfill Site

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is conducting a Five-Year Review of the York County Solid Waste and Refuse Authority Landfill, a Superfund site located in Hopewell Township. EPA inspects sites regularly to ensure that cleanups conducted remain protective of public health and the environment. This site was deleted from the National Priorities List, or NPL, in 2005. EPA's most recent review of the site in 2012 determined that the remedy continues to be fully protective of public health and the environment in the long-term. **Findings from this review will be available September 2017.**
