

EPA REVIEWS CLEANUP HELEVA LANDFILL

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is conducting a Five-Year Review of the Heleva Landfill Superfund Site located in North Whitehall Township, Lehigh County. EPA inspects sites regularly to ensure that cleanups conducted remain protective of public health and the environment. EPA's last review of the site in 2012 determined that the remedy continues to be protective of public health and the environment. **Findings from this review will be available September 2017.**
