

EPA REVIEWS CLEANUP

Eastern Diversified Metals

The U.S. Environmental Agency is reviewing the cleanup that was conducted at the Eastern Diversified Metals Superfund Site located in Rush Township. EPA inspects sites regularly to ensure that cleanups conducted remain protective of public health and the environment. EPA's previous review of the site in 2013 determined that the remedy continues to be protective. Findings from the current review being conducted will be available March 2018.
