The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has developed two Proposed Remedial Action Plans (Proposed Plans) for the North Penn Area 6 Superfund Site. One outlines options for addressing soil contamination at the J.W. Rex property and the other outlines options for addressing groundwater contamination at the Central Sprinkler property.

J.W. Rex Property

EPA's Preferred Alternative is identified in the Proposed Plan as **Alternative 5**: Excavation, Off-Site Disposal, and Institutional Controls. Soil would be mechanically excavated using conventional construction methods. Excavation activities would be scheduled during normal business hours to minimize disruption to surrounding residential areas, and the excavated areas would be protected with temporary fencing and warning signs at the conclusion of daily activities.

Central Sprinkler Property

EPA's Preferred Alternative is identified in the Proposed Plan as **Alternative 3**: Proposed Modification: Enhanced Reductive Dechlorination (ERD). The ERD will treat the groundwater in place by enhancing the conditions for naturally occurring microorganisms to consume the contaminants in the groundwater. This Proposed Plan will speed up the remediation process in response to the low-level concentrations of contaminants in the groundwater at that property.
