Dear Mr. Ullrich:

The Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA) staff has reviewed the draft Notice of Intent to Delete Operable Unit 2 (OU2) of the South Andover Salvage Yards site (Site) from the National Priorities List (NPL). This notice and action constitutes a partial delisting of the Site from the NPL. Based on the NPL Deletion Criteria, Deletion Procedures and Basis for Intended Site Deletion, the MPCA concurs with the determination that Responsible Parties have implemented all response actions required for OU2, that no further response action is appropriate for this particular operable unit, and that the remedial activities conducted at the Site to date have been protective of public health, welfare, and the environment.
