NPL Site Narrative for Duell & Gardner Landfill

DUELL & GARDNER LANDFILL Dalton Township, Michigan

Conditions at listing (December 1982): The Duell & Gardner Landfill covers 30 acres in Dalton Township, Muskegon County, Michigan. The site, which was privately owned, was in operation from about 1969 to 1975. The site is poorly covered and there is evidence of open dumping of leaking unsealed containers. General refuse and garbage are scattered about the site. PCBs, ethyleneimine, and other chemicals were detected in soil. Contamination of ground water is suspected.

Status (July 1983): EPA is preparing a remedial plan outlining the investigations needed to determine the full extent of cleanup required at the site. It will guide further actions at the site.
