

NPL Site Narrative for Spartan Chemical Co.

SPARTAN CHEMICAL CO. Wyoming, Michigan

Conditions at listing (December 1982): The Spartan Chemical Co. Site covers 2 acres in Wyoming, Michigan. Since 1952, the company has blended, packaged, and distributed chemicals, including industrial solvents and thinners. Nearby residential wells have become contaminated with trichloroethylene, perchloroethylene, chloroform, and other organic compounds. These wells have been abandoned and residences connected to a municipal water supply.

Status (July 1983): Conditions at this site are currently being addressed through an enforcement action against parties responsible for wastes at the site.
