Dear Mr. Jouras:

Pursuant to conditions specified in a permit (see attached) issued by the City of Chicago, radiation monitoring was required to be performed at the above referenced site. AECOM Technical Services, Inc. (AECOM) provided the required radiation surveillance on September 28, 2016 for excavation related to an installation of a utility service line.

Surveying was performed within the excavation and on the spoil removed at 500-03 N. Peshtigo Ct. (refer to sketch). The excavation was composed of a single trench north of the intersection of E. Illinois St and N. Peshtigo Ct. The trench was approximately 20-feet long and 3-feet wide in length with varying depths of 41 to 55-inches below ground surface (bgs).

The monitoring did not indicate that the fill soils were above the removal action level established by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) for the Streeterville area of Chicago. The USEPA removal action level for Chicago's Streeterville area is 7.1 picocuries per gram (pCi/g) total radium (Ra-226 + Ra-228). Gamma radiation count measurements for the project were recorded using Ludlum Models 2221 survey meter and an unshielded 2 x 2 inch NaI probe (Model 44-10). For the instrument used, the gamma count threshold indicative of the 7.1 pCi/g removal action level is 18,315 (S/N: 132844) counts per minute (cpm) unshielded.

The field gamma measurements within the excavation and of the spoil during the excavation process did not exceed the instrument threshold previously stated and predominantly ranged from a minimum of 5,600 cpm to a maximum of 11,000 cpm unshielded. Based on field observations there was no indication of the presence of radiologically-contaminated fill and/or an exceedance of the USEPA removal action level of 7.1 pCi/g total radium. A copy of the permit and a field sketch documenting the area where work was performed, have been included as attachments.

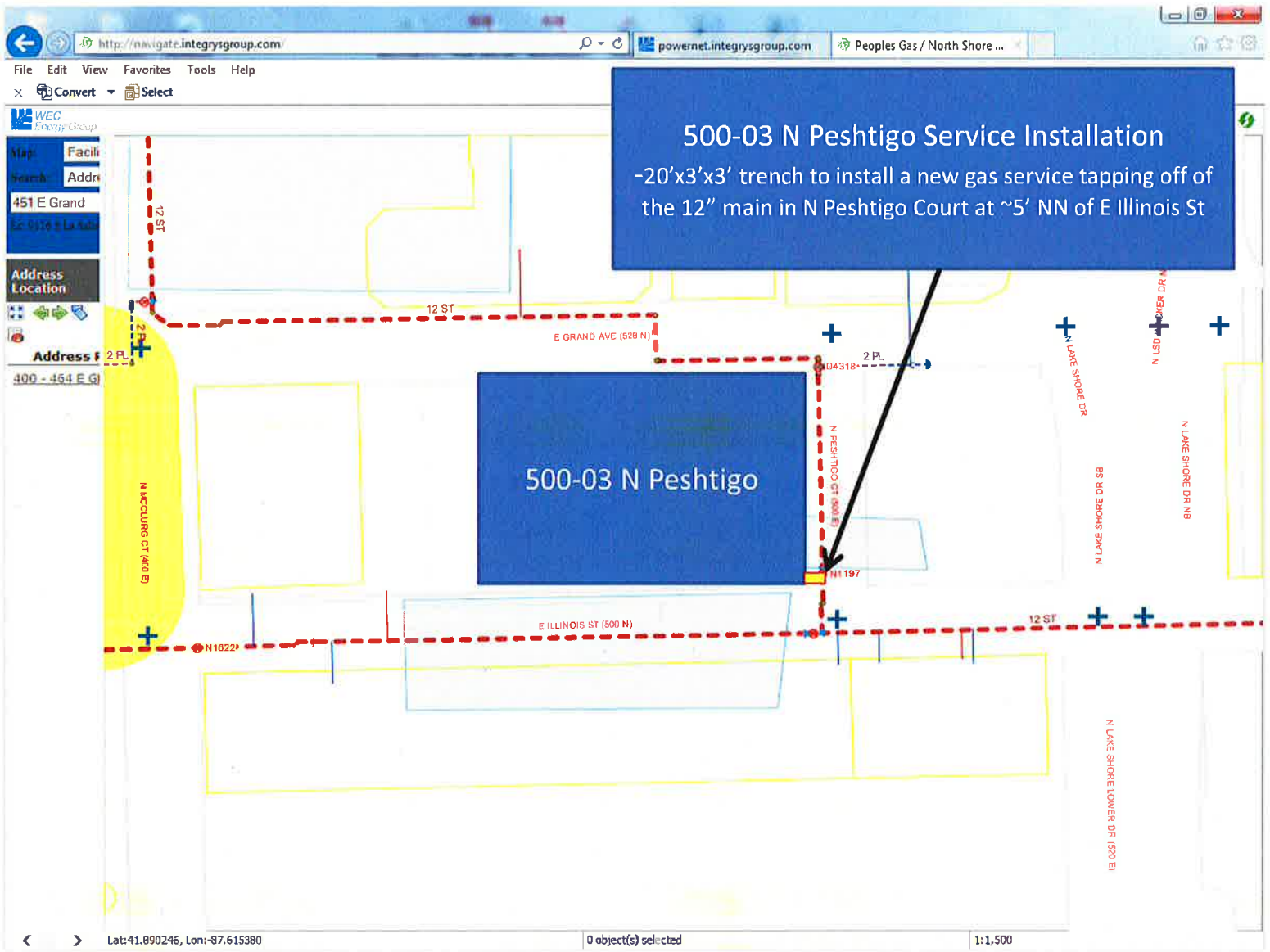

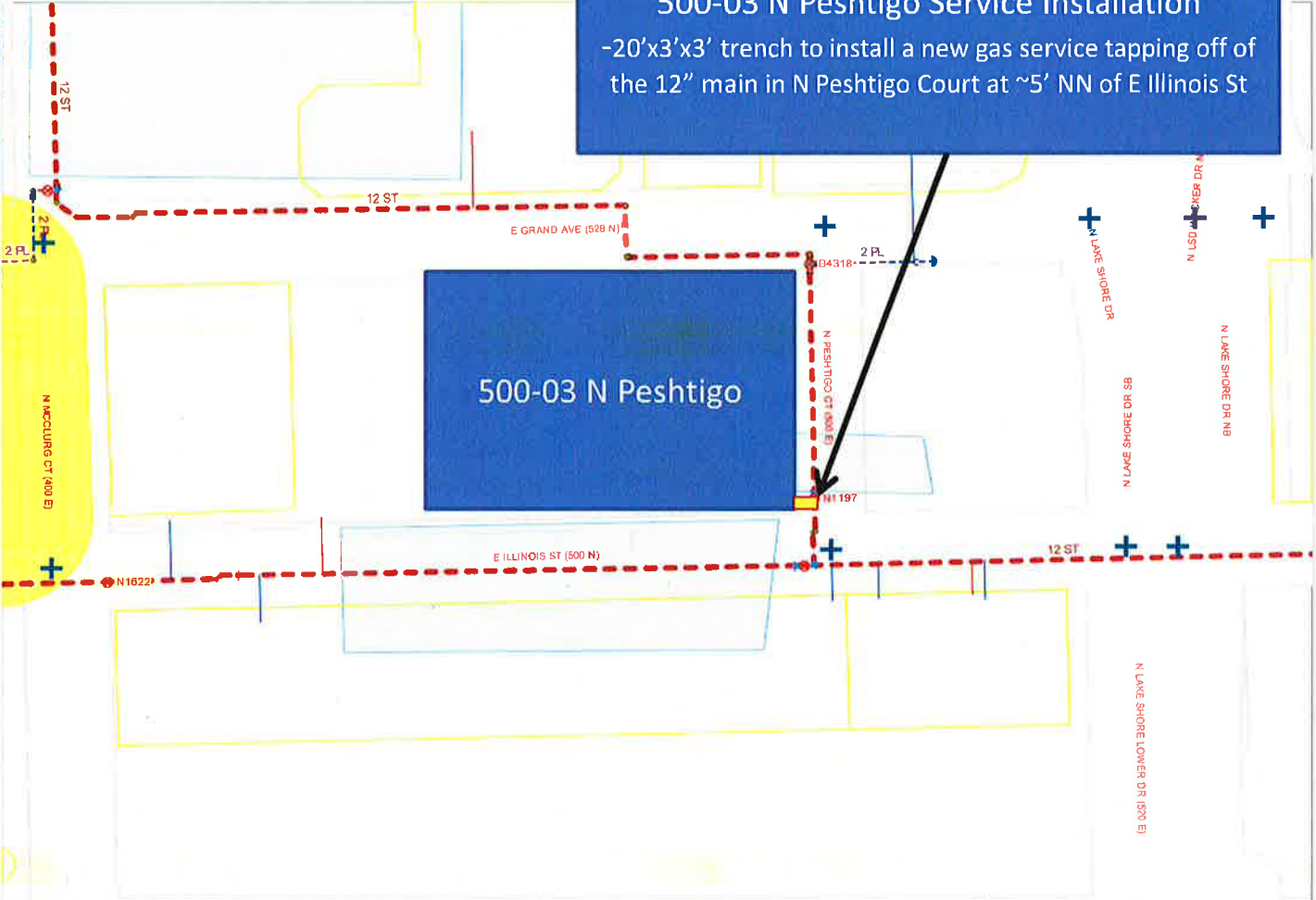

Restrictions:

1. If Arterial Street Outside CBD, Then Start no earlier then 9:00 A.M. and end no later then 4:00 P.M.
2. Contractor must notify DIGGER at 312-744-7000 no less then 48 hours (exclusive of Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays) but no more then 14 calendar days in advance of the start of the excavation or demolition, unless the excavation date was provided with the application and remains unchanged. Prior to 26 calendar days the Contractor must notify DIGGER to renewal the dig date! It is the Excavator's responsibility to request refreshing of marks when needed, but no longer than 28 calendar days after the last requested date. When applicable, all excavation areas are to be clearly marked in safety white paint prior to calling DIGGER. White paint is not required for joint meets or emergency work. Excavators requesting dig tickets are responsible for the protection of utility markings at the job site. Any markings of underground utilities utilizing utility colors must be done by facility owners or authorized agents only.
3. A copy of the permit must remain on-site for inspector's review.
4. If Non-Arterial Street Outside CBD, Then Start no earlier then 7:00 A.M. and end no later then 3:00 P.M.
5. Permittee must provide a sign which identifies the telephone number and company or person performing the work. Signage may be affixed to barricades.
6. All work shall be in accordance with CDOT Rules and Regulations for Construction in the Public Way and City of Chicago Municipal Code. Work to be performed as per plans and specifications. All traffic control will be the responsibility of the contractor, and must comply with all CDOT and MUTCD standards.
7. Contractor must secure plating over all openings in the roadway and secure all sidewalk/parkway openings during non-working hours until such time when the road surface is restored.
8. No work in or use of the public right of way is to be done when a special event is taking place. It is up to the applicant to determine if an event is scheduled. To obtain a listing of programs or events within the City of Chicago please dial 311 when you are within the City boundaries.

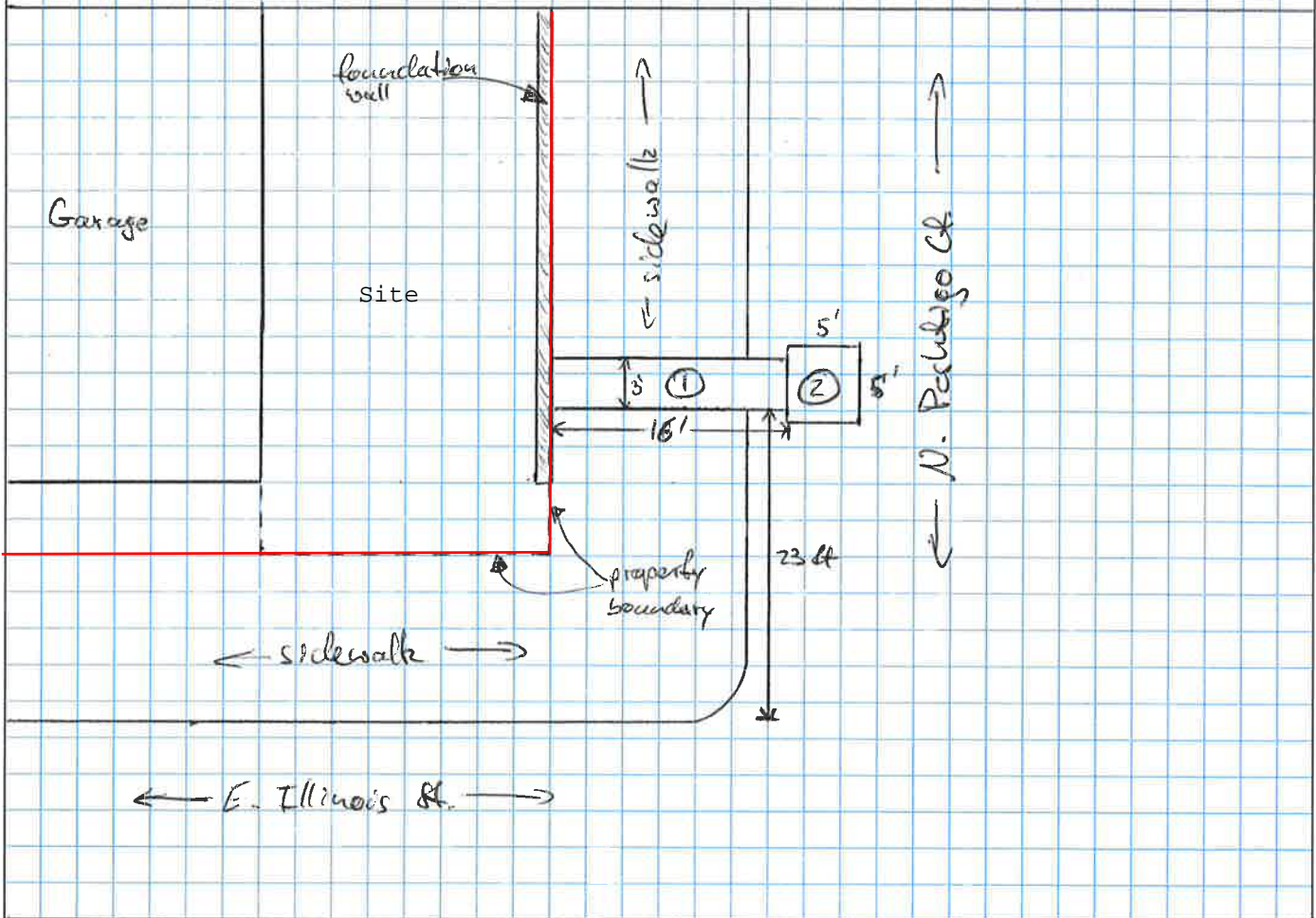
