Stan A. Huber Consultants, Inc (SAHCI) was hired by your firm to provide radiation monitoring during sidewalk and curb removal at 401 N. Michigan Ave. in Chicago, Illinois. The monitoring was performed by Glenn Huber and Brian Schmidt, SAHCI Health Physics Technicians, on August 10, 2017 through August 12, 2017.

<u>Instrumentation</u>

Surface gamma scans were performed using a Ludlum Model 2221 Scaler / Ratemeter (serial no. 126496) with attached Ludlum Model 44-10 2"x2" NaI detector (with 6" collimated lead shield). The instrument was calibrated on October 14, 2016. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) action level of 7.1 picocuries per gram (pCi/g) total thorium for this instrument is 7,029 counts per minute (cpm).

The average background count rate for this location was determined to be 1,800 cpm.

Soil Gamma Scans

Gamma surface scans were performed using the Ludlum Model 2221 Scaler / Ratemeter described above. Survey data was collected by surveying the surface of the ground after the layer of concrete sidewalk and curb was removed. No excavation took place beyond concrete removal.

The maximum gamma count rates for the single lift were recorded on the attached Radiation Survey Form. The surface count rates after concrete removal ranged from from 1,800 cpm to 3,200 cpm. No count rates were identified at any time that exceeded the threshold limit of 7,029 cpm.

Additional Monitoring

Since no count rates were identified above the 7.1 pCi/gram threshold limit, no additional soil sampling, air monitoring, or personnel monitoring were performed.

Regulatory Notification of Survey Completion

A copy of this report will need to be submitted to both the City of Chicago Department of Public Health (CDPH) and USEPA, as required.


