Pursuant to conditions specified in a permit issued by the City of Chicago, radiation monitoring was required to be performed at the above referenced site. AECOM Technical Services, Inc. (AECOM) provided the required radiation surveillance on October 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, and 24<sup>th</sup> as well as December 19<sup>th</sup>, 2018 for excavations related to sidewalk and planter installations along East Grand Ave.

Surveying was performed within the excavation and on the spoil removed at 510 N. Peshtigo Ct. (refer to annotated drawing). The excavations were located within the sidewalk and curb right-of-way (ROW) along the south side of E. Grand Ave. west of the intersection of E. Grand Ave. and N. Peshtigo Ct. The total length of the excavation of planters and sidewalk installation was approximately 200-feet long, 12-feet wide, and excavated to a depth of 2-feet to 3-feet below ground surface (bgs).

The monitoring did not indicate that the fill soils were above the removal action level established by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) for the Streeterville area of Chicago. The USEPA removal action level for Chicago's Streeterville area is 7.1 picocuries per gram (pCi/g) total radium (Ra-226 + Ra-228). Gamma radiation count measurements for the project were recorded using a Ludlum Models 2221 survey meter and a shielded 2 x 2 inch Nal probe (Model 44-10). For the instrument used during the screening, the gamma count threshold indicative of the 7.1 pCi/g removal action level was 6,669 (S/N: 172039) counts per minute (cpm) shielded. The field instrument background gamma readings collected for fill soil in the vicinity of the excavation areas was 2,000 cpm.

The field gamma measurements within the excavations and of the spoil during the excavation process did not exceed the instrument threshold previously stated and ranged from a minimum of 1,400 cpm to a maximum of 3,400 cpm shielded. Based on field observations there was no indication of the presence of radiologically-contaminated fill and/or an exceedance of the USEPA removal action level of 7.1 pCi/g total radium. A copy of the annotated drawing and tabulated results documenting the work performed have been included as attachments.






