Pursuant to conditions specified in the Right of Way (ROW) forms (attached) issued by the City of Chicago Department of Public Health (CDPH), radiation monitoring is required to be performed at the above referenced site if work will excavate or expose fill soil. AECOM Technical Services, Inc. (AECOM) arrived at the referenced address on October 3rd to provide the required radiation surveillance. A contractor for Peoples Gas Light & Coke Co. planned to adjust a valve box within the street ROW ahead of a City of Chicago street repaving project along Michigan Avenue. Upon arrival, AECOM personnel were informed that excavation was unnecessary due to the valve box being located on the sidewalk and not within the street ROW. Therefore, no thorium monitoring was required since the valve box was not adjusted and no excavation was performed.
