This informal meeting is to provide the community with an update on the Remedial Investigation and Feasibility (RI/FS) Study being conducted for the site. Patrick Bayou is located in a mixed urban, highly industrialized petrochemical area in southeast Harris County approximately 1 mile north of State Highway (SH) 225 in Deer Park, Texas. The site consists of

contaminated sediments within the Bayou, a portion of the East Fork tributary, and associated wetlands.
