Additional Information

The Empire Bank is considering foreclosing on a property located at 933 West Chase in Springfield. The property is a closed commercial facility formerly known as Kamtel, Inc. (owned by Ratibhai Patel) - reportedly a circuit board manufacturer. The business has declared bankruptcy. Empire Bank had a Phase II assessment completed which found elevated levels of metals in the soil at the site. Empire Bank is considering whether they can disclose the actual levels to DNR, which has requested the data. For now, they simply want to report "elevated levels".

Update 11/15/11: Empire Bank forwarded an electronic copy of the Phase II report, part of which is attached to this report. The contaminants that were found to be elevated in one soil boring and associated groundwater at the site, compared to MRBCA non-petroleum site Default Target Levels, are: Ammonia, Arsenic, Chromium, Copper, Lead, and Selenium.
