Thanks for speaking with me today. Tomorrow morning I will send you some additional information on what EPA needs to perform an "Ability to Pay" analysis on OEA Housing Corporation. Generally speaking it's going to be three years of financial statements and/or tax information. There's also a form that needs to be filled out. Once we receive the information from you, our accountant will perform a financial analysis on OEA's ability to pay for response costs incurred during the emergency response.
