Grove Gulch Work Kickoff

EPA is excited to see work on the first of the BPSOU corridor projects outlined in the Consent Decree, Grove Gulch, start on August 5. The Grove Gulch project is designed to protect surface waters, like Blacktail Creek, by capturing stormwater runoff and contaminants resulting from historic mining operations. It is located immediately east of Lexington Street and south of I-90. EPA has confidence in the contractors and professionals carrying out the work at Grove Gulch and will provide robust oversight through the duration of the project. Cleanup is scheduled to be completed in December 2024 with revegetation work occurring after the spring thaw. For additional information on Grove Gulch, <u>please</u> <u>visit BPSOU.com</u>. Lead (Pb) update

EPA continues to develop a Proposed Plan to implement a new lead cleanup level for the BPSOU based on the 2024 residential soil lead guidance. Much progress has been made over the past month, and EPA is eager to share the Proposed Plan once it is finalized. When the Proposed Plan is released, there will be an opportunity for the public to provide comments. We will keep the Butte community updated as there is more information to share, but anticipate providing an update on the new cleanup level and the public comment period in the near future.

Westside Soils

The draft Remedial Investigation (RI) final report for the Westside Soils operable unit (WSSOU) has been reviewed by MT DEQ and is with EPA. The Site team continues to work on the Feasibility Study (FS) with hopes of having it completed later in 2024. Progress updates will be provided over the coming months.
