



PROJECT OVERVIEW

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Region 10 is kicking off the Remedial Action or cleanup of the North Ridge Estates (NRE) Superfund Site.

The purpose of the project is to remove soil contaminated with asbestos and asbestos-containing material (ACM) at NRE. The soil to be removed is primarily in the top two feet and deeper in some areas.

Despite removal of ACM over the years, annual freezing and thawing cycles continue to push debris to the surface. The excavation process scheduled to start in the summer of 2016 will ensure that contaminated soil and ACM does not continue to surface. The cleanup of the NRE Superfund Site is planned to be completed over **three construction seasons** generally between May and October as work is unable to be conducted during winter months and freezing weather. Season one will start in July and be completed by October 2016; the entire cleanup is expected to be completed by December 2018.

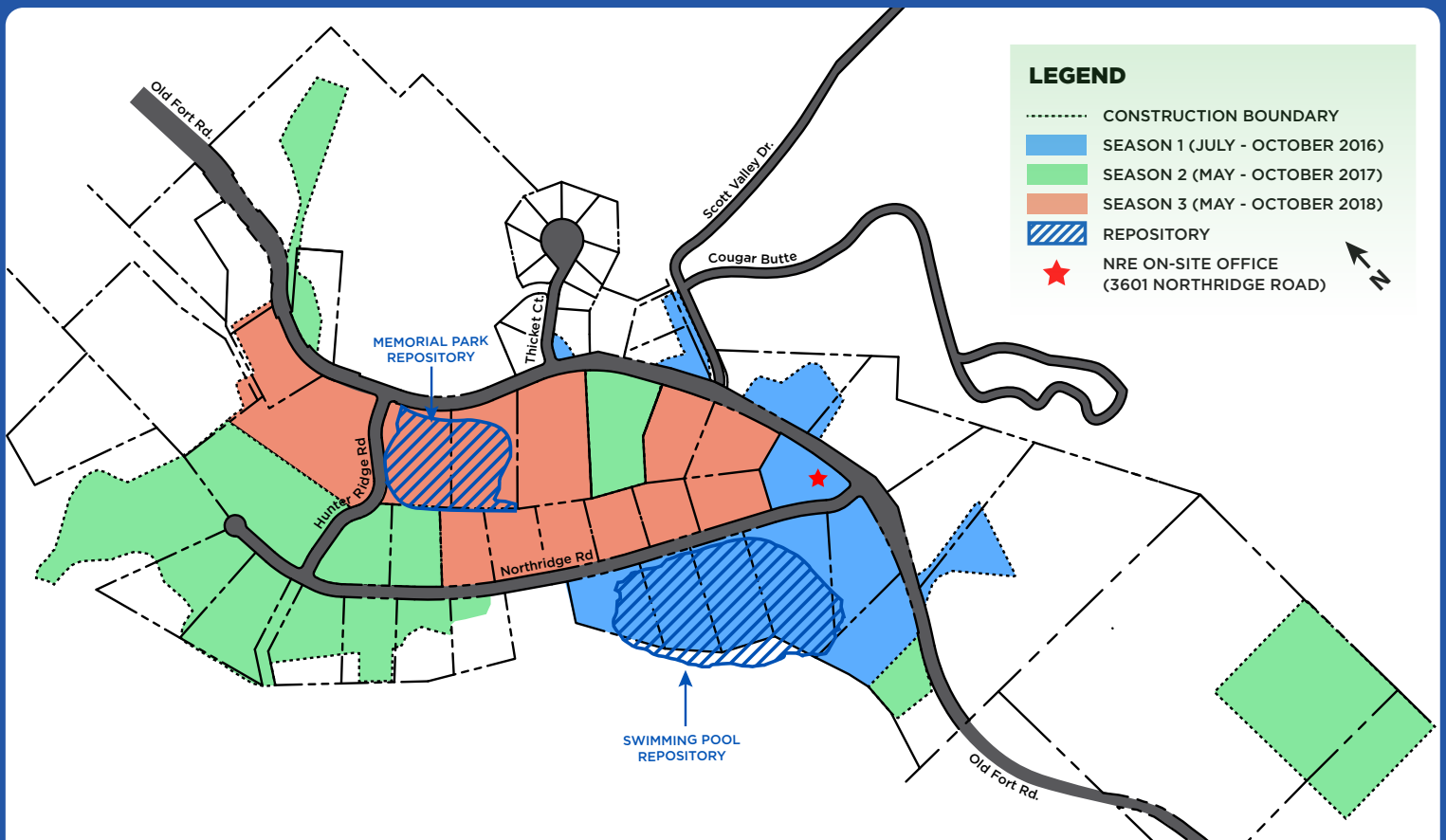
