The Muni of Anchorage phoned the NRC today and filed a report regarding public asbestos exposure at (b) (6) 26th Ave, Anchorage, AK. NRC case no. 1359953

Scott Campbell, Chief of Inspections will meet us on site tomorrow at 1:00 pm. The Muni contacted the property owner and his attorney and advised them of our joint Muni-EPA inspection to check for asbestos and collect samples. The property owner said he is sending his maintenance person with keys to open doors for us.

Residents have been sent to temporary shelter at a number of locations including the Sullivan Arena. One or more residents may be on site tomorrow to ask permission to enter their apartments and retrieve personal items. My understanding is some apartment units have not been impacted by the asbestos drywall removal. If we can help make a distinction about that tomorrow I would support doing that. We won't know until we arrive and inspect.
