SUBJECT: Eielson Air Force Base Request for Emergency Permit

1. Request Explosive Ordnance Disposal (EOD) specialists be authorized to emergency detonate munitions that were determined to be unsafe for their intended purpose and are not safe for shipment out of Alaska for disposal. The munitions for disposal include 30 Chaff RR-180 (12 lbs) and 30 cartridges Impulse BBU-48A/B (5 lbs) totalling 17 lbs.
2. The assets were soaked with JP-8 jet fuel during an aircraft mishap. The assets were deemed unfit for transport and demilitarization due to the added unknown hazard from the addition of JP-8.
3. We respectfully request permission for disposal. The detonation will take place at the Eielson Air Force Base EOD proficiency Range as an open detonation. The EOD specialist in charge of the operation will be TSgt Travis Tomassi.

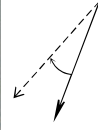
Installation boundary



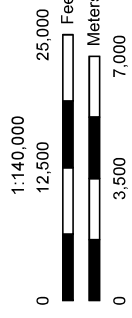
EOD Demolition Range
