Site Name: Piper Aircraft Corporation/City of Vero Beach Water & Sewer Department Superfund Site

Size: 80 acres

Existing Site Infrastructure: Water, sewer, natural gas and electricity are available on site.

Current Site Uses: The current uses include an active manufacturing facility for small commuter and business planes. Several airport support businesses are also located on site.

Use Restrictions: Access to two small groundwater treatment areas is restricted. Groundwater use is prohibited.

SETTING:

- The site is zoned for industrial uses.
- Surrounding land uses include commercial, industrial, and residential areas.
- The site is bordered to the north, east and west by the Vero Beach Municipal Airport. Aviation Boulevard borders the site to the south.
- As of December 2017, EPA had data on six on-site businesses. These businesses employed 844 people and generated an estimated \$252,655,913 in annual sales revenue.
- Surrounding population: 0.5 mile, 677 people 2.5 miles, 30,870 people | 4 miles, 63,798 people.

REMEDIAL STATUS:

 Piper Aircraft manufactured airplanes and stored chemicals on site in the 1970s. Its operations resulted in groundwater contamination.

- EPA placed the site on the Superfund program's National Priorities List (NPL) in 1990.
- Cleanup included groundwater pumping and treatment, and removal of an underground storage tank and contaminated soil
- A new groundwater extraction and treatment system was installed in 1998. Groundwater treatment and monitoring are ongoing.
- Construction of the site's remedy finished in 1998.
