Site Name: New Bedford Superfund Site

**Size:** 18,000 acres

**Existing Site Infrastructure:** All major types of infrastructure are located on site. **Readiness for Reuse:** EPA's Superfund cleanup work, in concert with state-sponsored navigational dredging, facilitates both redevelopment and environmental protection. Cleanup of shoreline contamination will be coordinated with the city's construction of a recreational riverwalk. Marine terminal construction is coordinated with environmental cleanup. Additional riverside redevelopment opportunities will exist as cleanup is completed.

Use Restrictions: Restrictions limit consumption of fish, shellfish and lobster in and around the harbor until contaminant levels decrease.

## **SETTING:**

- The site extends from the northern reaches of the Acushnet River estuary south through the commercial harbor of New Bedford and into parts of Buzzards Bay.
- Site surroundings include New Bedford harbor, area communities, the Acushnet River estuary and Buzzards Bay.
- Site areas are zoned for commercial, residential, industrial, recreational and conservation land uses.
- Surrounding population: 0.5 mile, 1,013 people 2.5 miles, 90,752 people | 4 miles, 121,301 people.

## **REMEDIAL STATUS:**

- Companies produced electric devices on site from 1940 to the late 1970s.
- Two manufacturing facilities improperly disposed of industrial wastes containing polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs), contaminating the harbor bottom for about 6 miles from the Acushnet River into Buzzards Bay.
- EPA has developed the final, sitewide cleanup plan. Cleanup is ongoing.
- Dredging and off-site disposal of PCBcontaminated sediment will be completed in about five years.
